

CYSA Travel Assessments

Travel assessments take place only one time per year, in May, to assign players to teams for both the following Fall and Spring seasons. This tryout is for the Fall 2010 and Spring 2011 seasons.

All players registering for Travel programs **MUST** participate in spring skills assessments and it is **strongly advised** that players **attend BOTH nights** for their age group. By attending both nights it provides CYSA a much better, more complete assessment of a player's skills in order to place them on a team that closely matches their skill level. Players can have an off night and by attending **BOTH** assessment sessions CYSA will be able to better assess.

If you have a conflict on an assessment night, please contact the appropriate travel director in order for CYSA to be aware of the situation.
